tasting notes

The delicate aromas ensure compatibility with food. It shows hints of red berries and a terroir based minerality with a fresh, light finish on the palate.

70% Grenache, 30% Carignan

about the harvest

Old, shy yielding goblet vines were harvested slightly prematurely for the Rosé.

in the cellar

After crushing and destalking a short period of skin contact was allowed before pressing. After overnight settling, the juice was racked into fermentation at 14°C. After stabilisation the wine was bottled early. Both varieties are vinified separately before blending.
